The Government announced that all children will be returning to school on Monday 8th March.

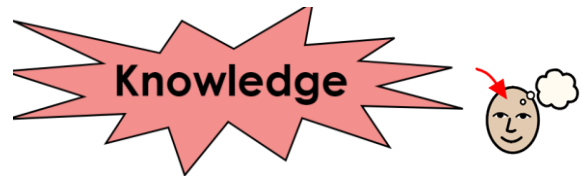
Remote Learning Packs:

EYFS have been learning how to order by size and how to measure in different ways.

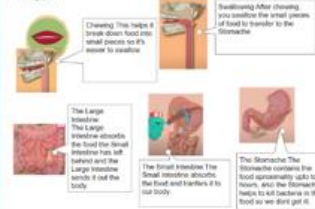


Queens Victoria's Life
