What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- In English, we have been reading books all about frogs and writing our own information. In Maths, nursery have been pretending to be frogs and learning about positional language. Reception have been learning the names of 3D shapes.

Year 1- In English we have been writing a Missing poster for our lost penguin. In Maths we have been finding half of a shape and amount.

Year 2- In English we have been writing a report on Seaside Towns. In maths we have been finding a third of numbers, counting in fractions, recognising unit and non-unit fractions and finding equivalent fractions.

Year 3- In English we have been investigating historical facts about Howard Carter and have been writing a diary entry from the perspective of one of Howard Carter's workers. In maths we have been investigating and finding equivalent fractions and finding fractions of amounts.

Year 4- In English this week, Year 4 have been writing a play script for a scene from Cinderella. In Maths, we have been using fractions and counting in tenths.

Year 5- In English this week, we have been researching facts about yellow spotted lizards. In Maths, we have been learning how to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers.

Year 6- In English this week Year 6 have been exploring alternative endings to famous fairy tales. In Maths, we have been measuring and drawing angles accurately.
