

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## What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week in English, we have been reading 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Nursery have made their own porridge, just like the bears in the story and it was delicious! In Maths, we have been comparing sizes linked to the language 'big, medium and small'. Reception have been writing letters to baby bear to say sorry from Goldilocks. In Maths, we have continued with our learning all about adding 2 groups.

Year 1- This week in English, we have been writing a description of a dinosaur. In Maths, we have been working on counting forward and backwards within 50.

Year 2- This week, in Year 2, we have been writing super sentences about Florence Nightingale. We have enjoyed learning about her life. In Maths, we have been measuring objects in cm and m and comparing them. We have looked at lots of sources in History, ready for our visit to the Annie Kennedy statue

Year 3- This week in year 3, we have begun our discovery of the Mayan civilization, We have begun to think about character traits in Charlie and the Chocolate factory. In Maths, we have been learning about unit and non unit fractions.

Year 4 - This week in English, Year 4 became reporters, reporting on the events of The Great Kapok Tree. In Maths, we have been continuing to work on our length and perimeter.

Year 5- This week in English, we have been focusing on the difference between formal language and informal language. In Maths, we have been learning how to round decimal numbers to the nearest whole and tenth.

Year 6- This week in English, year 6 have really enjoyed reading our next class text: The Explorer. In Maths, we have been learning how to calculate Area and Perimeter.

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
