What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week Nursery have been reading 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We have been exploring tall and short and had fun retelling the story. We followed instructions and planted our own beans. Reception have been reading 'Jim and the Beanstalk'. We wrote sentences about what we might see at the top of the beanstalk. In Maths, we have been comparing tall and short and used cubes to measure lots of objects and we even measured each other.

Year 1- This week in English, Year 1 have been writing instructions on how to grow a dinosaur! In Maths, we have been partitioning numbers up to 50.

Year 2- This week, in Year 2, we have been writing non-chronological reports about Florence Nightingale. We have enjoyed learning about how she changed hospitals and saved so many people's lives. In Maths, we have been solving problems using cm and m.
