What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week Nursery and Reception have been learning all about chicks. We had a special delivery of 10 eggs and we have been very lucky to watch them hatch. In Maths, Nursery have been making shape chicks and Reception have been ordering numbers within 20.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a retell of Mama Panyas Pancakes. In Maths, we have been using our timetables to make arrays.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week in English, we have written our own version of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch!' In Maths, we have been learning how to tell the time and have even made our own clocks to help us!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been writing a play script based on our story The Plot on the Pyramid. In maths, we have been finding fractions of amounts.

<u>Year 4 -</u> This week Year 4 have been writing a narrative of Romulus and Remus. In Maths, we have been turning fractions into decimals.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a setting description of Victorian London. In Maths, we have been measuring angles with a protractor.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week year 6 have been continuing their revision of work they have leant this year in preparation for SATs. They have also begun learning how to play tennis and cricket - showing some excellent promise in these sports.
