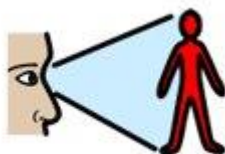

What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week, we have been reading lots of books about Pirates and sea creatures. We have been busy using Purple Mash to record our learning and painted super sea creature pictures to share our learning.

Year 1- This week Year 1 have been completing their home learning, they have used Purple Mash to create their own stories and tell the time to the hour and half hour.

Year 2- This week in English, Year Two have been fact finding and planning a report about seaside holidays in the past. In Maths, we have been learning to read and write the time to the hour and half hour on an analogue clock.
