What has each class been learning about this week?

Nursery- In Nursery this week we have been learning all about Humpty Dumpty. We have also explored eggs and made yummy scrambled eggs! In maths, we have been learning about sizes and talking about things that are big and things that are small.

Reception -In English, we have been reading the story Owl Babies. We had lots of fun joining in with the words and making our own owls. In Maths we have been making patterns and learning how to spot and correct mistakes.

Year 1- In English, we have been writing our instructions on how to behave in school for Boris the bear. In Maths, we have been finding number bonds to and within 10.

Year 2- In English, we have been exploring the story, 'The Tiger Child.' We have written super instructions to help the tiger. In Maths, we have been adding and subtracting 10.

Year 3- In English this week, we have been using our persuasive writing techniques to create a persuasive and informative leaflet about London and it's landmarks. In maths we have been learning how to exchange whilst adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers.

Year 4- This week in English Year 4 have been planning and writing a diary entry in the 1st person; Hercules. We have really enjoyed learning about Hercules and his tasks. In Maths we have been subtracting 3 and 4 digit numbers, exchanging where necessary. In Science, we answered one of Aristotle's key questions 'If we add solids to water, what happens?'
