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### What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week Nursery have been singing the rhyme 'Pat a Cake, Pat a Cake'. We have been joining in our favourite number rhymes. In English, Reception have been reading the story called 'Cake'. We have been writing to the character called Cake, to tell him what to expect at a party. In Maths, we have been learning to count groups of objects to find out how many we have *altogether*.

Year 1- This week in English, we have been writing a non-chronological report about London. In Maths, we have been subtracting by making 10 and using bar models to find the difference.

Year 2- This week in English, we have been writing an excellent explanation about 'The Superb Soccamatic!' Year 2 have used terrific time words and technical vocabulary to explain how it works. In maths, we have made brilliant pictograms and been able to answer questions about them.

Year 3- This week in English, we have been writing an informal letter to Ug's family to ask for help in the battle against those pesky woolly mammoths. In maths, we have been learning how to convert pence and pounds and how to add amounts together.

Year 4- This week in English, Year 4 have been writing an explanation text about the roles within Ancient Rome. In Maths we have been finding the area of 2d shapes counting squares. In Science, we have begun making parts of the digestive system using junk modelling equipment.

Year 5- This week in English, we have been writing an explanation text about how to survive in extreme cold weather conditions. In Maths, we have been learning about how to add and subtract fractions with different denominators.

Year 6- This week in English we have been writing our non-chronological reports on animals from the rainforest. Year 6 have used a great variety of noun phrases to keep our writing from being repetitive and we have also used lots of interesting facts to keep our writing exciting. In maths we are now able to calculate area and perimeter.

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
