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## What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week in English, EYFS have been reading the story 'Handa's Surprise'. We have enjoyed learning all about the story and tasting the different fruits that Handa put in her basket. In Maths we have been practising our counting skills and recognising more and less.

Year 1- This week in English, we have been writing an alternative ending to the Queen's Handbag. In Maths, we have been building and representing numbers to 50.

Year 2- This week in English, Year 2 have written some amazing alternative endings to the story, 'The Monster Machine!' In Maths, we have been learning about 2D shapes, their properties and have even drawn some!

Year 3- This week in English, Year 3 have been putting their knowledge of The Stone Age to the test by creating a non-chronological report. In maths, we have been creating bar charts and tables to represent data and answered questions about our data.

Year 4- This week in English, Year 4 have been finding the features of a diary and looking at life as a Plebeian. In Maths, we have been finding equivalent fractions and fractions greater than 1.

Year 5- This week in English, we have been writing a setting description to describe a castle that Stella from our class novel has found. In Maths, we have been learning about decimal numbers and how to convert fractions to decimals.

Year 6- In maths we have worked hard to learn the properties of shapes so we could sort them into Venn diagrams.
