### What has each class been learning about this week?

**EYFS-** This week we have been reading the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We have had lots of fun retelling the story and pretending to be the Giant. In Maths, we have been learning all about tall and short. Nursery have been ordering by size and Reception have been measuring using cubes.

**Year 1-** This week, Year 1 have been writing an alternative ending to our story The Three Little Pigs and the Big Bad Book. In Maths we have been looking at weight and mass and have learnt to measure the weight of objects.

**Year 2-** This week, Year 2 have been writing an alternative re-tell of 'What the ladybird heard,' We are so proud of the super word choices that the children have been making! In Maths, we have been counting in fractions! In topic, we have using maps and keys to navigate our way around a farm!

**Year 3-** This week in English, Year 3 have become news reporters and have written a newspaper article about the events in Pompeii in 79 AD. In maths, We have learned how to find a half and a quarter.

**Year 4-** This week in Maths, we have been learning about decimals. We have looked at fractions e.g. 8/10 and turned it into a decimal. In English, we have been writing a Newspaper Report about the Fall of Rome! We have looked at recorded speech and how to write it accurately.

**Year 5-** This week in English, we have been learning about play scripts. We wrote our own play script about Little Freak and performed the play in class. In Maths, we have been learning how to multiply and divide decimal numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000.

**Year 6-** This week in English we have been designing a travel brochure. We have loved trying to use persuasive language to persuade customers to travel to our destination. We have also enjoyed creating some professional designs for our leaflet. In maths we have begun our SATs prep and have shown great progress in our arithmetic scores.

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
