What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week, we have been learning about animals that live at the zoo through the stories 'Lets go to the jungle' and 'Dear Zoo'. The children have done some fantastic writing and some brilliant art work. In Maths, Nursery have been practising their counting skills and Reception completed their learning all about 'Odds and Evens'.

Year 1- This week we have been writing our own transport poem in English. In Maths, we have been learning to read the time to the hour.

Year 2- This week, Year 2 have written brilliant letters as Hamish the cat. In Maths, we have been learning about capacity and have been reading scales in litres and millilitres. We have been superb scientists, investigating what plants need to survive.
