Well done to Afia for her fabulous Christmas Reindeer design!!

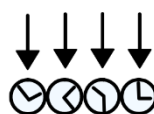

What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week Nursery have been reading the story Dear Santa and counting baubles on the Christmas tree. Reception have been reading the story 'Stickman'. We have been using our phonics to write posters and in our maths, we have been learning about 'heavy and light'.

Year 1- This week we have been writing a setting description in English. In Maths, we have been ordering groups and numbers to 20 and comparing them.

Year 2- In English we have begun to plan and write our own space stories. In maths we have been making coin totals, comparing, totalling and finding the difference between amounts of money.

Year 3- This week we have been writing an explanation text to say how Stonehenge was built. In Maths, We have been busy recapping prior learning and working on dividing by 8

Year 4- This week in English, we have been looking at the story Charlotte's Web and writing a character description about the character Fern. In Maths we have been multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100.

Year 5- This week in English, we have been learning about imperative verbs and how they are used to write instructions. In Maths, we have been multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000.

Year 6- In English this week, Year 6 have been writing persuasive leaflets about Anderson shelters, and in Maths they have translated and reflected shapes on four quadrant coordinate grids.

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
