What has each class been learning about this week?

Nursery This week we have been learning the rhyme 'Incy Wincy Spider'. We have been making our own spiders and using our counting skills to make 8 legs for them. We also worked together to make a giant web for Incy Wincy.

Reception This week in English, we have been reading the story 'Incredible You'. We have been drawing all the different things we can be when we grow up. In Maths, we have been sorting and matching by colour, size and pattern.

Year 1- This week in English, we have been inspired by our book 'Ruby's worry' and have written and drawn our own worries. In Maths, we have been looking at number bonds within 10.

Year 2- In Year 2 this week, we have become farm experts learning lots of information about farm animals! We loved milking our class cow, Daisy! In Maths, we have been learning our number bonds to 10, 20 and 100!

Year 3- This week in English, we have been learning about superlatives and persuasive language to write a persuasive postcard to a family member to convince them to come to London. In maths, we have been adding 1s, 10s and 100s.

Year 4- This week in English, we have been looking at the features of a Diary entry. We have thoroughly enjoyed reading the story of Heracles (Hercules)! In Maths, we have been using column addition to add 2, 4-digit numbers with no exchange and 1 exchange.

Year 5- This week in English, we have been writing a newspaper report to report the tragic death of Romeo and Juliet. In Maths, we have been learning how to add and subtract numbers using the column method.

Year 6- This week year 6 really enjoyed learning about evacuation in English. We spent time hot-seating as people who lived during The Blitz and tried to understand how they would be feeling. In science, we enjoyed sending messages using Morse Code via circuits.

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
