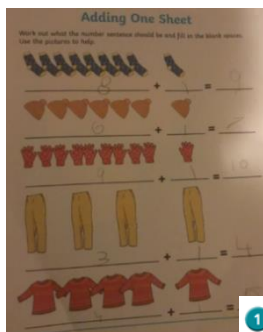


Our Remote Stars of the Week

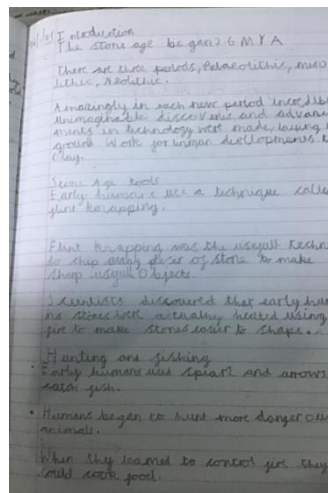
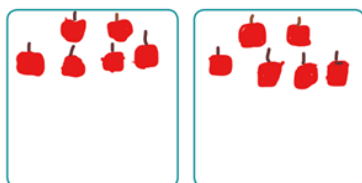


1 Annie has 12 apples.

Antarctica
