What has each class been learning about this week?

Nursery- This week we have been learning the song 'This is me' and the rhyme 'Faces'. We have made our own faces in different ways and had fun performing our songs. In Maths we have been counting and arranging objects to make a portrait.

Reception- This week in English, we have read the story 'Cake!'. We helped the character Cake, to learn all about parties and wrote shopping lists for him. In maths we have been learning all about 'One More' and had fun playing a new game called 'Ping Pong' to help us quickly recall one more.

Year 1- This week in English, we have been writing a story re-tell of Dipsy the Dinosaur Firefighter. In Maths, we have been learning about 2D shapes.

Year 2- In year 2 we have writing some delightful descriptions using lots of wonderful adjectives. In maths, we have been getting hands on while investigating and learning about the properties of 2d and 3d shapes.
